## I DRAW PREVIEW

Four teams are only 120 minutes of handball away from potentially winning the EHF Champions League Women 2021/22 title. But, of course, only one of them can ultimately lift the coveted trophy.

After the quarter-finals were completed last weekend, five-time champions Györi Audi ETO KC, Metz Handball, Team Esbjerg, and defending champions Vipers Kristiansand know they are the quartet battling it out for the title at the EHF FINAL4 Women 2022 on 4/5 June in the newly built MVM Dome in Budapest. The tension ahead of next month's final tournament is already starting to build as the four teams will soon learn who they will be playing against in order to get to the final.

**The draw for the semi-finals takes place at the Sport TV studio in Budapest on Tuesday 10 May at 18:00 CEST and will be streamed live on EHFTV as well as on the official EHF Champions League Facebook page and Home of Handball YouTube channel.** Some of the stars that will shine on court in June will also be present at the draw on Tuesday: Vipers' Nerea Pena, Metz's Hatadou Sako and Györ's Csejng Fodor, while Esbjerg's Henny Reistad joins in via Skype.

The four teams will be drawn from the same pot, following these steps:

- step 1: first team drawn for semi-final 1;**
- step 2: first team drawn for semi-final 2;**
- step 3: second team drawn for semi-final 1;**
- step 4: second team drawn for semi-final 2.**

The semi-finals 1 and 2 will not necessarily be played in that order at the EHF FINAL4; the exact playing schedule for Saturday 4 June will be announced in due time. The two losing semi-finalists will contest the third-place match on Sunday 5 June, followed by the two winners playing the big final.

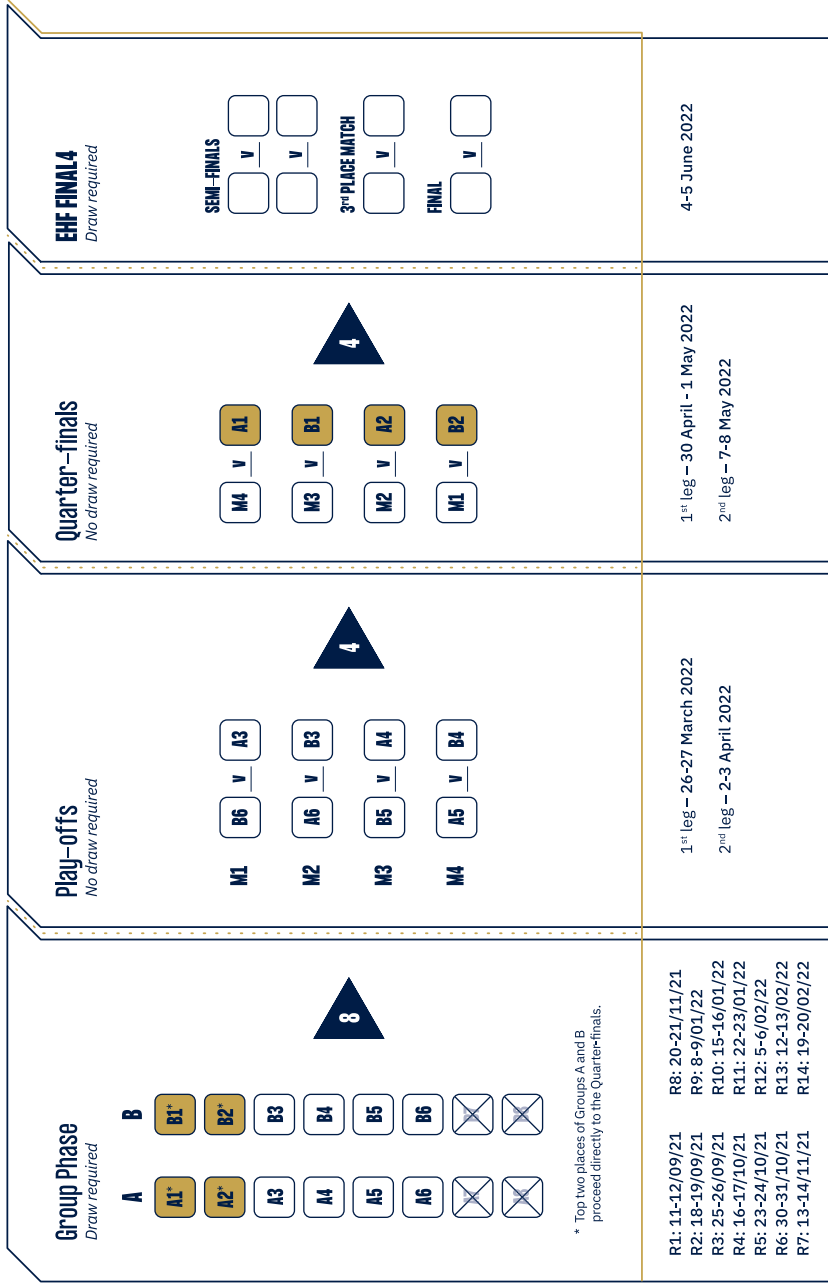

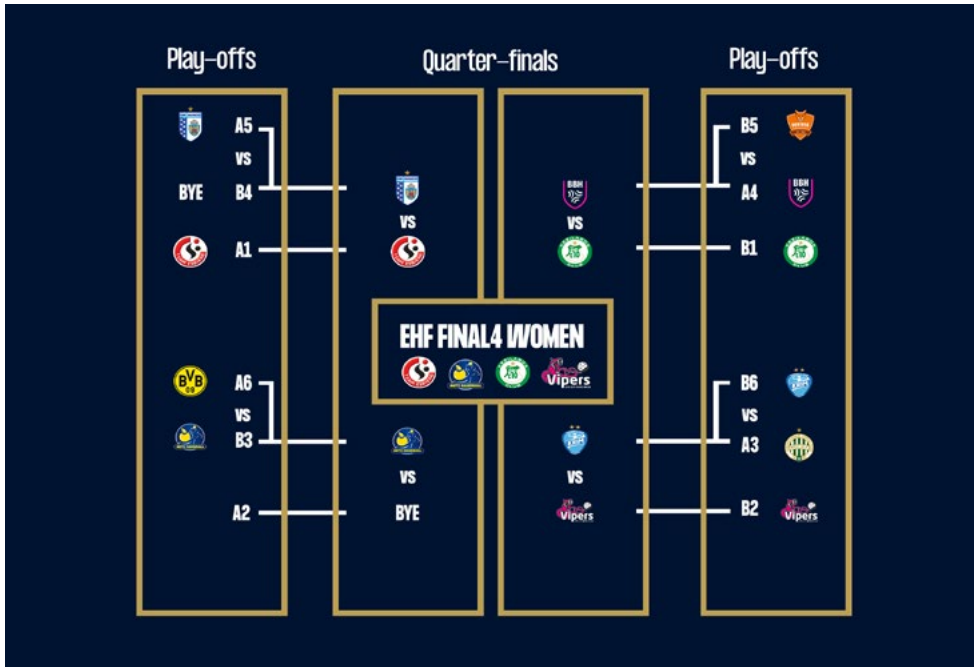

# ROAD TO THE EHF FINAL4 WOMEN 2022



Due to the war situation in Ukraine, all Russian and Belarusian clubs competing in European handball competitions have been suspended until further notice by the EHF Executive Committee on 28 February 2022.

In the EHF Champions League Women 2021/22, this measure involved Rostov-Don and CSKA, who finished second in group A and fourth in group B, respectively.

CSM Bucuresti, who finished fifth in group A and were set to take on CSKA in the play-offs, received a bye into the quarter-final, where they met Team Esbjerg.

Metz Handball, as the winners of the play-off tie with BV Borussia 09 Dortmund, were scheduled to play Rostov in the quarter-final, but have now qualified directly for the EHF FINAL4 Women 2022 in Budapest on 4/5 June.

# GYÖR ON TOP OF THE RANKINGS, TRIO AIM FOR THEIR THIRD TROPHY

## FACTS AND FIGURES: ALL THE NUMBERS YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE THE EHF FINAL4 WOMEN

**Four matches are ahead, 123 have been played, now the curtain will be lifted, which teams face in the semi-finals of the EHF FINAL4 WOMEN 2022 on 4/5 June in the new Budapest Arena. Here are many Facts and Figures you need to know prior to the draw event at Budapest - and you will see that record winners Györ top almost every ranking - except the top scorer list, while debutants Esbjerg are the 13th different club to qualify for the EHF FINAL4 WOMEN.**

**0** teams arrive unbeaten at the 2022 edition of the EHF FINAL 4 in Budapest

**0** teams from the same country will face at the EHF FINAL4 in Budapest, as four countries are represented

**0** times since the first Women's EHF FINAL4 in 2014, two teams from the same country had qualified

**0** teams have been part of all seven previous Women's EHF FINAL4 tournaments. Record winners Györ top the ranking by qualifying for the seventh time now

**0**

teams arriving from the play-offs in the quarter-finals managed to qualify for the EHF FINAL4

**1** debutant will be part of the eighth EHF FINAL4 in Budapest: Team Esbjerg - after FC Midtjylland (2014) they are the second ever Danish team at the final tournament of the Women's EHF Champions League

**1** - Györ and Esbjerg each lost only one of their 16 matches on the way to Budapest, ahead of Vipers and Metz with each four defeats

**1** team won both quarter-final matches: defending champions Vipers beat Krim twice

**1** goal was the smallest gap in the quarter-finals: Esbjerg took an aggregate 53:52 victory against CSM

**1** team managed to defend their trophy at the EHF FINAL in Budapest and even more: the 2017, 2018 and 2019 victors Györ. By winning the 2019 edition of the tournament, Györ were the first ever women's side to win the EHF Champions League three times in a row - now defending champions Vipers aim for the back-to-back victory

**1**

time only, Györ had missed the EHF FINAL4 in Budapest (in 2015). Once, when they were there, they missed the final only - in 2021, losing the semi against Brest

**1** EHF FINAL4 debutant managed to win the trophy at Budapest so far: CSM in 2016, beating Györ in the final after a penalty shoot-out - Esbjerg hope for the same this year

**2** former EHF Champions League winners (including all since 2017) are part of the quarter-finals: Vipers and Györ, the former winners Krim and CSM had been eliminated in the quarter-finals

**2** former IHF World Players of the Year are part of the EHF FINAL4 in 2022: the Norwegians Heidi Løke (Vipers/2011) and Stine Oftedal (Györ/2019)

**2** - after their premiere in 2019, Metz qualified for their second ever EHF FINAL4 in Budapest

**2** draws occurred in the six quarter-final matches: Brest vs Györ (26:26) and Esbjerg vs CSM (27:27)

**3** players aim for their sixth EHF Champions League trophy: the Vipers trio Katrine Lunde, Heidi Løke and Nora Mørk

**3** EHF FINAL4 participants had played in group B - Györ, Vipers and Metz -, only Esbjerg were part of group A

**4** countries were represented by the seven EHF FINAL4 winners so far: Hungary (4), Montenegro, Romania and Norway



**10** of 123 matches decided on court since the start of the group phase, ended by draws, two in the play-offs after zero in the play-offs.

**11** nations represent the previous winners of the EHF Champions League: Denmark, Hungary (6 titles each), Austria (4), Slovenia (2), Montenegro (2), Norway (2), North Macedonia, Spain, Croatia, Russia and Romania (one title each)

**12** goals were the biggest gap in a quarter-final match, when Györ beat Brest 35:23

times, the teams scored 45 or less goals in the 123 matches since the start of the group phase, zero in play-offs and once in the quarter-finals, at the first leg Brest vs Györ (21:21)

**13** different clubs were or are part of the seven previous EHF FINAL4 events: Györ (7 times), Vardar (5 times), Buducnost (4), CSM (3), Kristiansand (3), Rostov (2), Metz (2), Midtjylland, Volgograd, Larvik, CSKA, Brest and Esbjerg (all each once).

**16** matches had been played by all four participants of the EHF FINAL4 so far - Metz skipped the quarter-finals, Györ, Esbjerg and Vipers skipped the play-offs

**24** goals were the biggest margin since the start of the group phase, when Dortmund beat Podravka 38:14. The biggest gap in the play-off were 13 goals, when Metz beat Dortmund 32:19. The biggest gap in the quarter-finals were 12 goals (Györ vs Brest 35:23)

**25** times in 123 matches since the start of the group phase, the gap was ten or more goals - once in the play-offs (Metz vs Dortmund 32:19), once in the quarter-finals (Györ vs Brest 35:23)

**29** points in 16 matches are Györ's outcome including the quarter-finals, they are ahead of Esbjerg (26 points), Vipers (24) and Metz (23).

**39** goals were the low score in a single match, when FTC won 20:19 at Rostov, the low-score of the play-offs were 48 goals (FTC vs Krim 26:22),

the low-score of the quarter-finals 42 goals (Brest vs Györ 21:21).

**43** unbeaten home matches - including the 35:22 in the quarter-final against Brest are Györ's impressive run since November 2015, a 21:26 against FC Midtjylland

**49** times in 123 matches decided on court since the start of the group phase, the away team was victorious - only once in the play-offs (Metz at Dortmund) and twice in the quarter-finals (Esbjerg at Bucharest and Vipers at Ljubljana)

**65** of the 123 matches decided on court since the start of the group phase were won by the home sides, only two in the quarter-finals (Györ against Brest and Vipers against Krim).

**69** goals were twice the high-score since the start of the group phase - and in both cases, Metz were involved, losing 30:39 at Györ and winning 38:31 against Odense. 59 goals were the high-score in the play-offs (Krim vs FTC 33:26), 58 goals in the quarter-finals (Györ's 35:23 against Brest)

**110** goals were scored by Romanian world star Christina Neagu (CSM) in only 11 matches to top score current scorer list. Best scorer still in competition is second ranked Nora Mörk (96)

**398** goals each were conceded by Györ and Esbjerg to have the best defence of the four EHF FINAL4 participants, ahead of Metz (416) and Vipers (419)

**527** goals were scored by Györ in the 2021/22 season so far, in average, they scored 32.93 goals per match. By 502 goals, Vipers have the second best attack ahead of Metz (475) and Esbjerg (465)

**319** goals had been scored in the six quarter-final matches, an average of 53.16 per match

**6,712** goals had been scored in the 111 group matches (6079), which had been decided on the court, the six play-off matches (314) and the six quarter-finals (319), the average per match is 54.67.
